A Fond Farewell to Theresa

On May 1st this year, we said farewell to Theresa Roberts, the lead librarian at the South Tillamook County Library in Pacific City. Theresa retired after spending well over six years in our library system. Having come from a background in education, Theresa provided exemplary service to all patrons but she really excelled in youth work. Those who attended Theresa's storytimes will testify that she is a creative, exuberant, and engaging storyteller and she will be greatly missed.

We sat down with Theresa and asked her some questions about her career in our library system.

Q. What did you do before you worked in the library?

A. Before coming to the library I had worked for 16 years in the educational field as a reading assistant for at-risk students as well as an assist for ESL, special education and alternative ed. I loved working with children and was excited that I could continue to do similar work in the library through storytime, summer reading program and Mother Goose on the Loose.

Q. What is your earliest recollection of a library?

A. I was about six years old when my mother took me by myself to an old Carnegie library in upstate New York where we lived at the time. I immediately fell in love the quiet grandeur of that simple library. The librarian on duty noticed me hanging out with my mom and brought over a Beatrix Potter book which became the first book I checked out from a library. I loved those books (and still do) because they fit so perfectly in my small hand and the beautiful illustrations captivated my imagination. As soon as I could go to the library on my own, I went there all the time.

Q. Any funny stories, touching moments, greatest memories about working here?

A. Working with the babies and moms during Mother Goose on the Loose was the most rewarding part of my job. I realized right away that even young babies pick up and learn the songs and rhymes we recite each week. I love it when one of the little ones will come in on a non-Mother Goose day and give me the biggest smile and ask me to read or play 'goose' with them. They always brightened my day and I couldn't help but laugh and join in with their silliness.

Q. Any other parting comments you would like to make?

A. We are all living stories in progress and I just get to write a new chapter. I hope our library will inspire others to write their own love story, to live life deeply and find the beauty and wonder within themselves.
