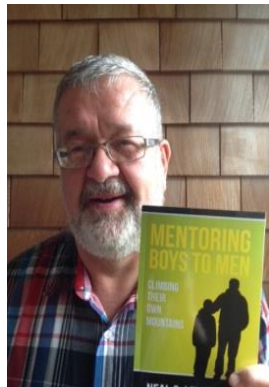


Author Neal Lemery to speak at Tillamook Library

Valentine Storytime at Garibaldi

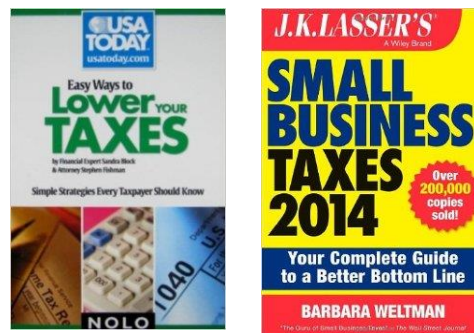

Visit the Bookstore!



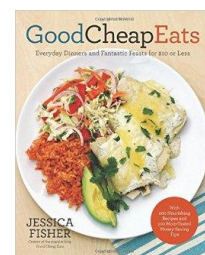
