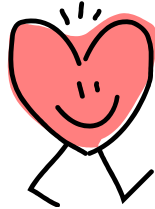
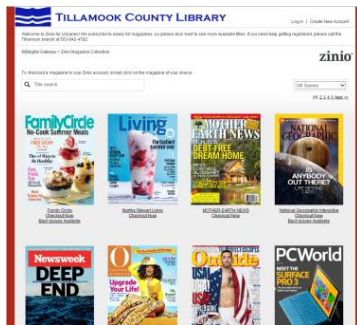


## Romance Section Changes

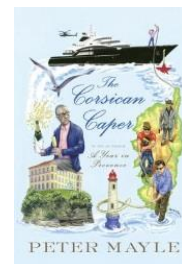
