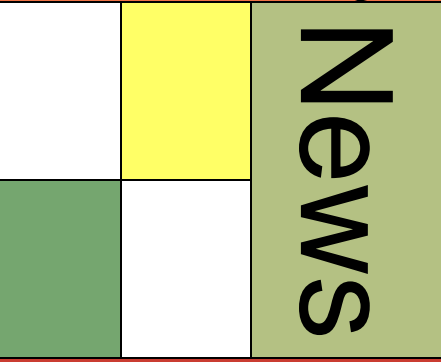
## You can meet Curious George!

## Visit the Bookstore!

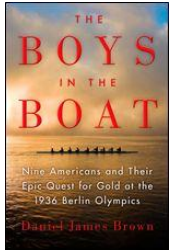
