Changes to Bookmobile Schedule



Now that summer is over, the Bookmobile will once again be on the fall schedule. Regular Bookmobile users should look

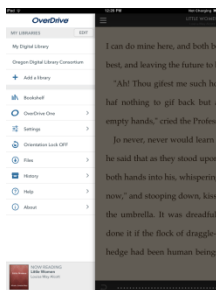

Changes for Interlibrary Loan (ILL)

When the Tillamook County Library does not have a book in the catalog, we often turn to a cooperative library service called InterLibrary Loan. We can borrow rare books from libraries near and far to broaden your access to materials. This is a time consuming process and requires postage to be paid both directions. Because of this, we will be instituting some changes to the Interlibrary Loan process effective October 1st. The biggest change will be the addition of a flat fee of \$3 per borrowed item. If you request a journal article, the fee will be 10 cents per printed page. You are still allowed six ILL items per month. You can request materials through ILL by talking to a staff person or by filling out the form on our website, found at www.tillabook.org.
