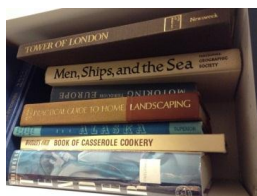
November Closures

Visit the Bookstore!



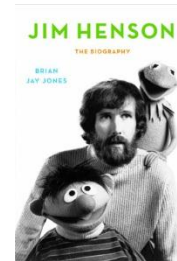
