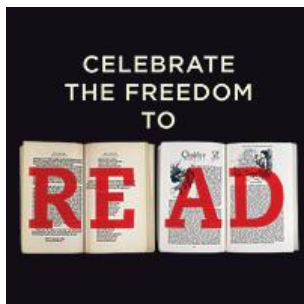
Mural Dedication and Open House to be held at Pacific City Library

Now that school has begun again, this doesn't mean the fun has to stop! Miss Melanie has regular storytimes for all ages, from birth to age 12.

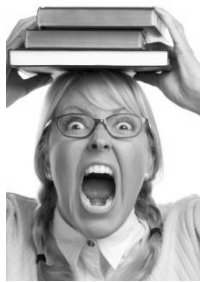
