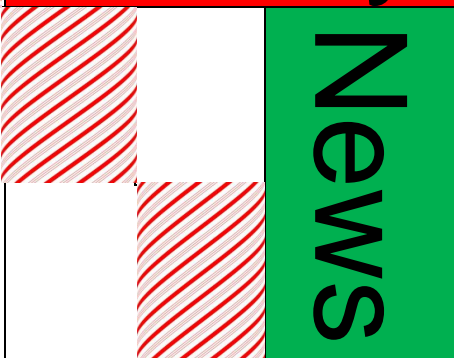

Christmas Movie Nights!

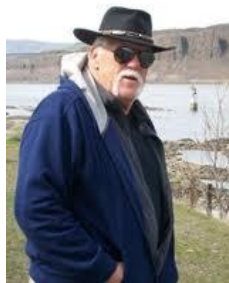

Visit the Bookstore!

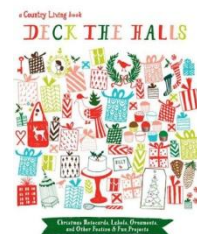
