In the meantime, please take advantage of Curbside Pickup, available at all six locations around the county. Call 503-842-4792 for details.

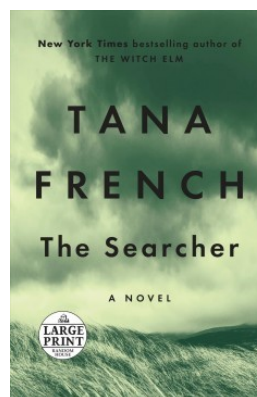
