## **New Copier Services at Tillamook Libraries!**



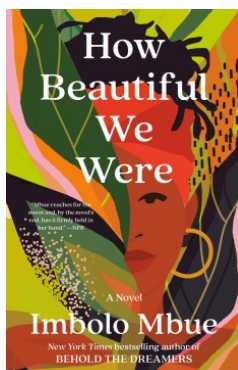
### **Copy Machine Upgrades at the Library**

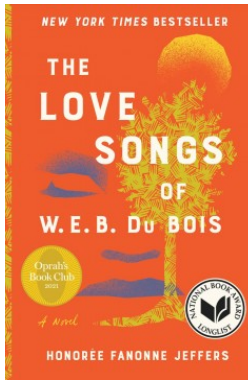
## Books That People Liked in 2021...

by Imbolo Mbue

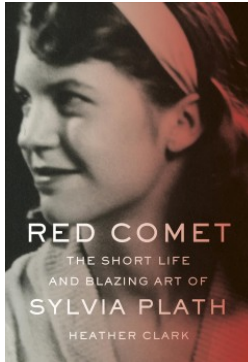
