WiFi Mobile Hotspots!

The Tillamook County Library now offers something called a WiFi mobile hotspot that you can check out for a week at a time, take it home, and you will instantly have a free internet connection for your phone, computer, or tablet. The only catch is you have to use it in an area that has a cell phone signal. You do not have to have a cell phone or a data plan for this to work. All you need is the WiFi hotspot and your own device to connect to it!

You can surf the internet, get homework help, attend classes online, stream music or movies, use the library's online resources, and so much more. Naturally, you do have to possess a library card in good standing to check out a hotspot. The Garibaldi and Bay City libraries are hosting some small salmon friends! We are partnering with Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife STEP (Salmon-Trout Enhancement Program) to hatch and release the salmon fry. Come into the library during November to see the baby salmon grow from eggs, to alevins, to fry, and learn about the life cycle of salmon.
