



## Library Foundation Quilt Raffle Winners



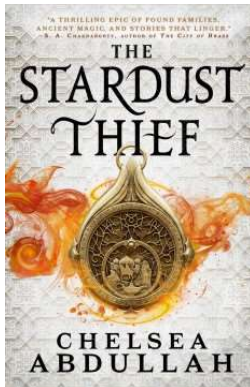
*Every Dog Has Its Day* is the named quilt raffled by the Tillamook County Library Foundation at this year's county fair. Katie and Hannah Javadi held the winning ticket. They purchased a set of three tickets with the intent of giving the bright cheery quilt to their father if they won. Their father, Cyrus Javadi, is delighted with the gift.

The quilt was donated to the Library Foundation by Tillamook County Master Quilter Cathie Favret. The quilt was machine pieced and quilted by Cathie in March 2020 from a pattern by Colorwerx. Cathie is a staunch supporter of the Library and the Foundation. She single handedly jumped started the Foundation's Library Park project, when she donated over 30 quilted pieces for sale in 2018.

The \$415 raised by the sale of the raffle tickets will go into the Foundation's general fund. The Foundation uses raffle/sale revenue, bookstore revenue, donations, and investment interest to fulfill its mission of supporting the County Library System with extras not included in the overall library budget. Such support has included providing extra programs, program food, technology such as the copier-scanner-fax machines purchased for all branches last year, and kick starts for programs like the Book Club Book Kits. The Foundation is also constructing Maxwell Library Park on the west side of the Main branch. The park is an outdoor venue with benches and landscaped mini-gardens. A stage is currently under construction. A labyrinth is planned.

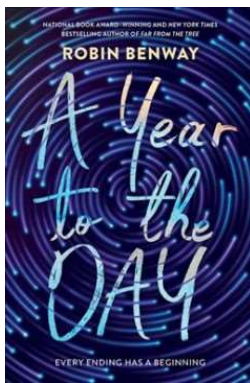
## Newly Arrived Books

by Chelsea Abdullah

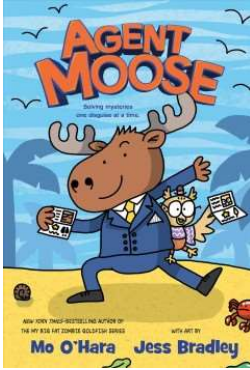
