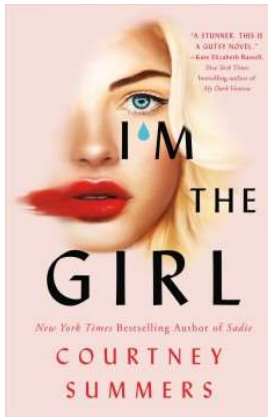
Did You Know...

Come to the Tillamook Main Library the last week of October/beginning of November and grab as many of the 2019 magazines as you would like!

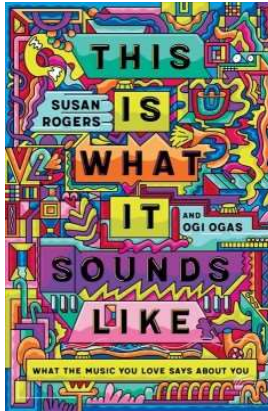
