




Community Listening Session at Bay City

Meet Local Author Carla Albright!


Meet and talk with local author Carla Albright! Join us at the Garibaldi Branch Library at 3:00pm on Wednesday, March 29th!

Let's learn how to get the best years out of our tools!


Read to a Dog!

Join us on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of every month at 3:30pm!


Our next storytime will be Wednesday, March 29th!

Storyteller Series

Join us at the Tillamook Main Library Saturday, April 8th at 2:00pm to hear fantastic tales from Alton Takiyama-Chung!

Japanese-Korean storyteller Alton Takiyama-Chung, grew up with the stories, superstitions, and the magic of the Hawaiian Islands. He has performed across the country. He has created multicultural programs sharing Asian folk tales from many countries as well as legends from Hawaii. Through historical research and from conducting oral history interviews, he tells stories from the Hawaiian Monarchy and from the Plantation Days, as well as those which describe the Japanese American Experience of WWII. Alton has performed at the Chicago History Museum, the Bishop Museum, the Japanese American National Museum, the Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oregon Historical Society, University of Hawaii at Hilo, Oregon State University, the International School (Portland, OR), University of San Diego, as well as many library systems and schools.

On May 1, 2023 the Overdrive app will be discontinued. This applies only to smart devices with the Overdrive app downloaded. If you use Library2Go on your desktop or laptop computer or already use Libby, you will be unaffected.

The people at Overdrive have created a new app called Libby which provides users an improved experience and better features than their Overdrive app. In Libby you will have access to the same items, and your loans, holds and wish list items will still be available to you.



by Jane Yolen


