Bring your favorite pillow or other comfy seating to settle in. We'll provide the popcorn. All ages welcome!



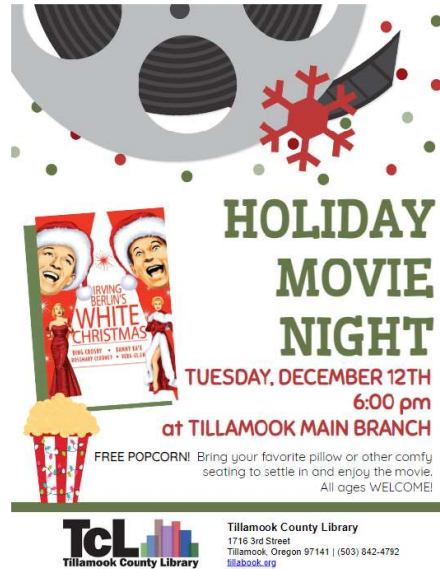
Holiday Guitar Performance with David Rogers

The goals are to observe and participate in the development process of fish and learn about their life cycles.*

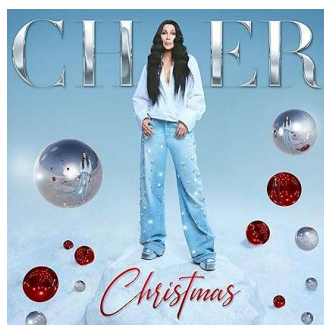
