



The Repair Roadshow Is Back!

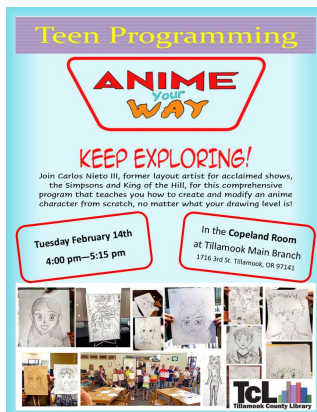
Have items at home in need of repair? Call the Garibaldi Branch Library to get on the schedule and come Saturday, February 11th!
