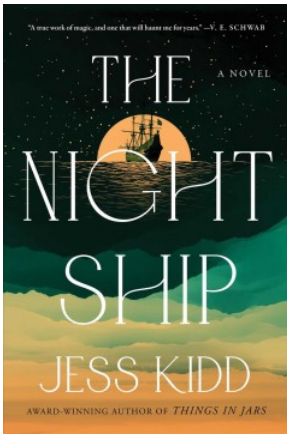

by Jess Kidd

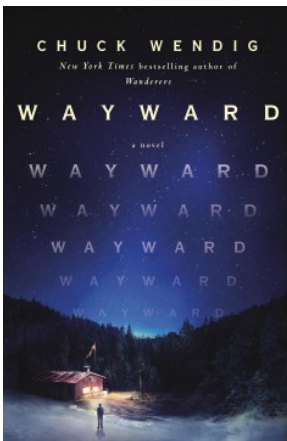
