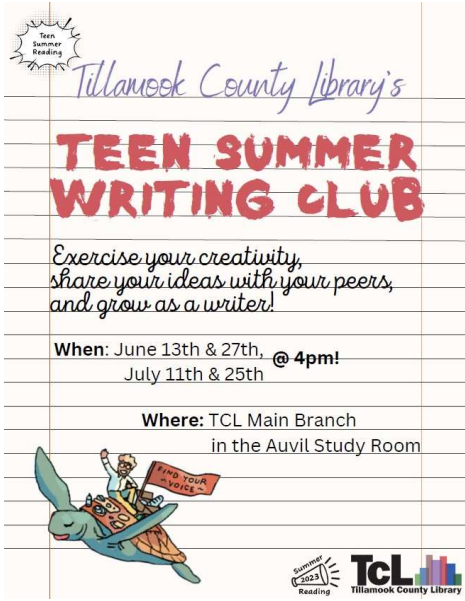

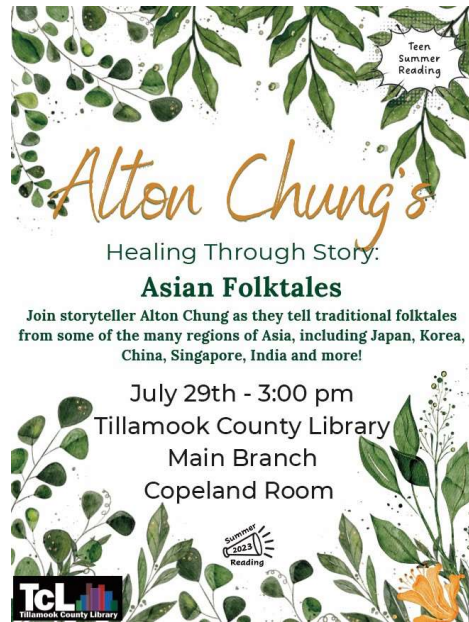
Teen Drop-in Creations
