Have items at home in need of repair? Bring them to the Garibaldi Branch Library Saturday, June 10th!

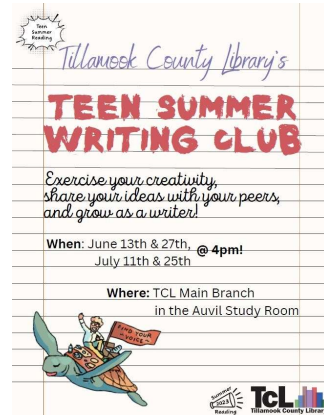

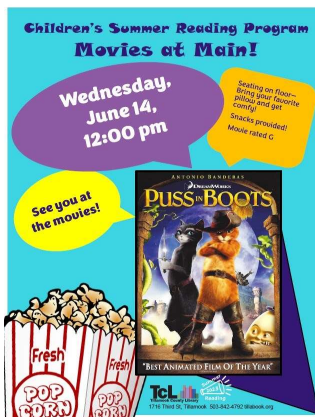

Summer Reading Children's Movie



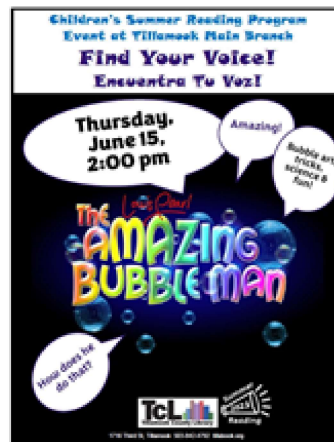

COMMISSIONERS SEEK LIBRARY BOARD MEMBER

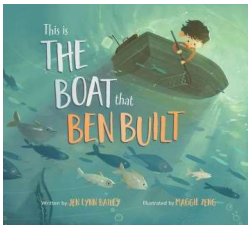
The Tillamook County Library is seeking applications for one library board seat on the library board of directors.

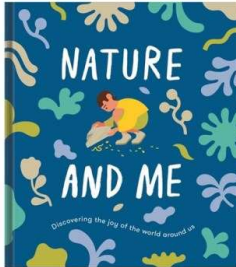
New Arrivals in Kids...
