## December Ukulele Jam

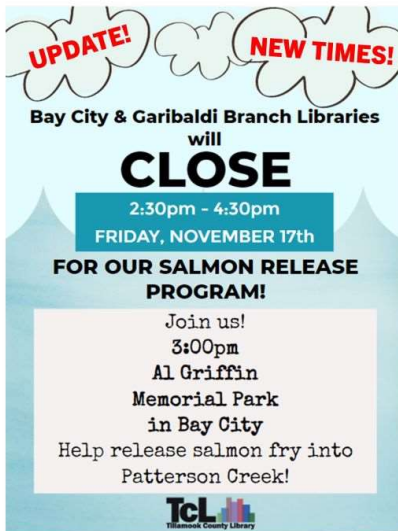
Come and join us at the Tillamook Main Library for a fantastic and fun ukulele jam with Mr. Bill!

## Successful Salmon Fry Release

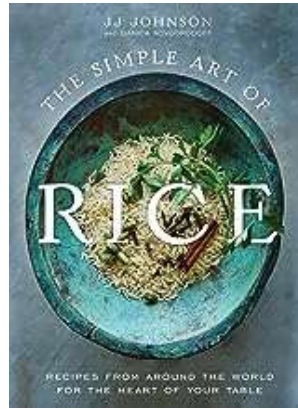
The salmon fry at the Bay City Branch Library and the Garibaldi Branch Library have been released!

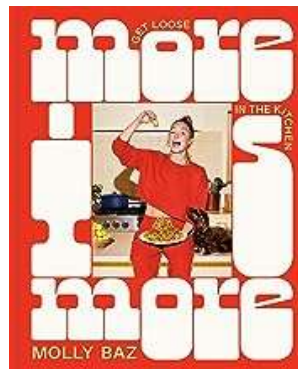
