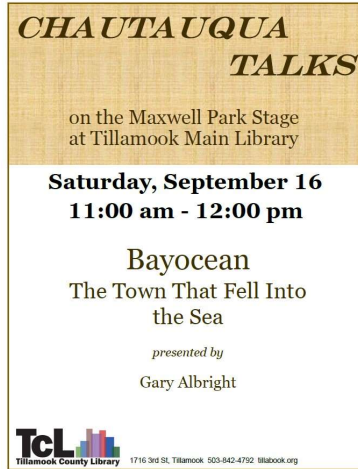

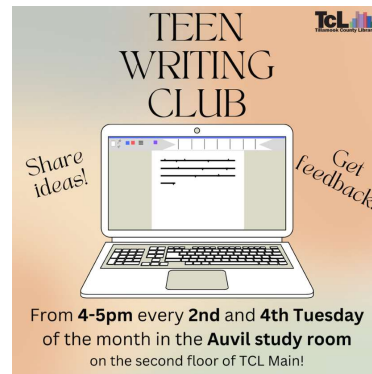

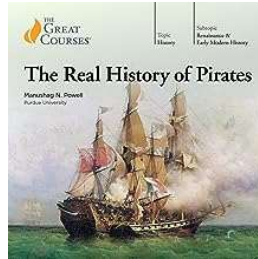
## Teen Game Night

**Manushag N. Powell**

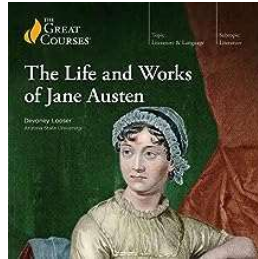
