



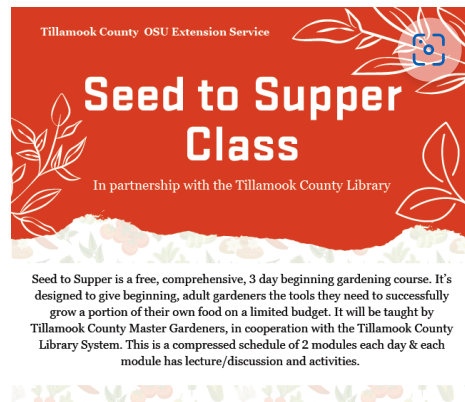

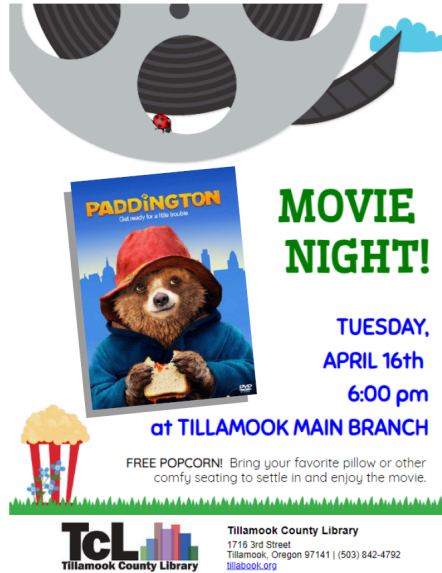
## Owls of the Pacific Northwest

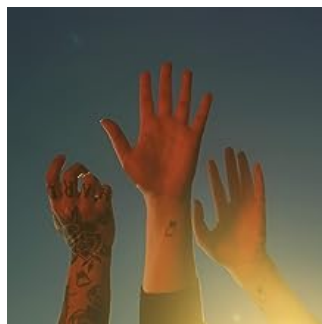

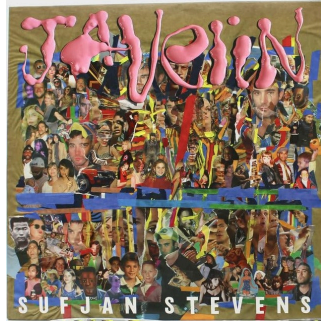
