
## Games in the Gloam

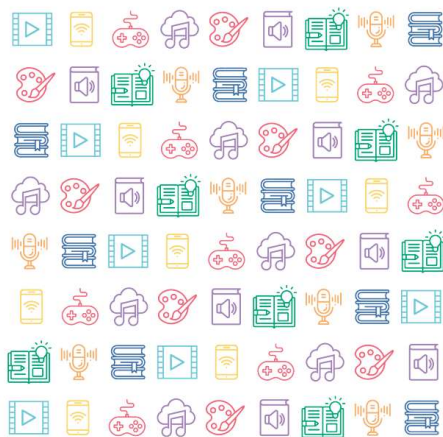
## Maker Saturday

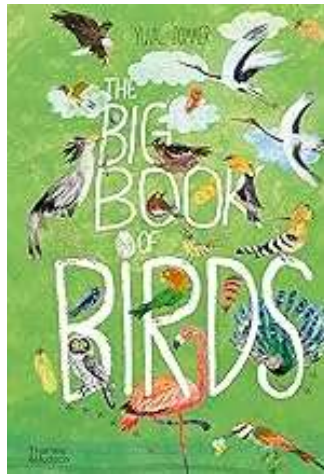

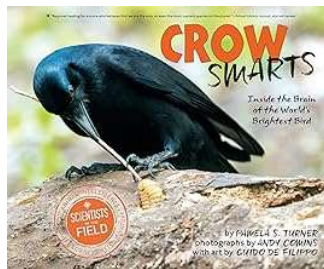


## Bird Atlas : Amazing Facts, Fold-Out Maps, and Life-Size Surprises
