Let's create beautiful and intricate pysanky! Pysanky, also known as Ukrainian Eggs, are eggs decorated using a wax-resist method.


Join Susan Nimersheim at the Tillamook Main Library on Saturday, March 30th at 2:00pm. Create your own pysanka and learn the background for this unique art!




