ORDINANCE No. 31

WHEREAS, by agreement with the State of Oregon,
Tillamook County regulates recreational vehicle parks, travelers'
accommodations, restaurants, and swimming pools, and

WHEREAS, the expeditious enforcement of those regula-
tions could be most easily carried out through the adoption of the
applicable state regulations governing these accommodations and
their enforcement through the Tillamook County Enforcement
Ordinance; now, therefore,

The TILLAMOOK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS as
follows:

1. The following Oregon administrative regulations are
hereby adopted as County law:

Recreational Vehicle Parks - OAR 333-31-001
through 333-31-085

Travelers' Accommodations - OAR 333-29-005 through
333-12-060

Restaurants - OAR 333-32-001

Swimming Pools - OAR 333-60-005 through 333-60-220

2. Violation by any person of any of the regulations
set forth in Paragraph 1 is hereby prohibited.


3. Violation of this ordinance may be prosecuted under Tillamook County Planning and Zoning Ordinance No. 35, dated February 9, 1983; or by any other criminal or civil proceeding authorized by law.

4. This ordinance being deemed necessary by the Board of Commissioners for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Tillamook County, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
