This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on August 29, 2018 at the request of Gordon McCraw, Tillamook County Emergency Management Director. The Board, being fully apprised of the representation of the above-named person, finds as follows:

1. "National Preparedness Month" creates an important opportunity for residents of Tillamook County to prepare their homes, businesses, schools, and communities for any type of emergency; from the smallest emergency to the Cascadia Subduction Zone Earthquake and Tsunami.
2. During the month of September, the Tillamook County Emergency Management Department and other federal, local, private, and volunteer agencies are working to increase public activities in preparing for emergencies and educating individuals how to take action.
3. Taking steps toward personal preparedness and ensuring households, businesses, schools, and community organizations are prepared for disaster can save lives following a major crisis. Being prepared will also speed up recovery efforts and lessen the impact of economic devastation.
4. Participating in the "National Preparedness Month" will not only help increase awareness about what type of disaster can happen in a community but also help identify what steps and actions should be taken to enhance the level of preparedness for such disasters.
5. The Board of Commissioners would like to officially recognize all community partners, volunteer, and civic organizations, who routinely offer their invaluable services to the community. The Emergency Volunteer Corps' of Nehalem Bay and South County were created to promote a culture of preparedness for citizens in those areas while also supporting preparedness in all of Tillamook County.




