This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on September 18, 2019 at the request of JoAnn Woelfle, Tillamook County Parks Department Interim Director. The Board, being fully apprised of the representation of the above-named person, finds as follows:

1. Bradley K. Webster was one of the original founding members of the Tillamook County Parks Advisory Committee. He joined the committee in 1993 and was a member until 2014. His enthusiasm and love of parks was a vital part of the Parks Advisory Committee's dynamics for 21 years.
2. Bradley Webster was a long-time advocate of building a community shelter where members of the public could gather and recreate in all weather conditions. The community shelter was built in large part due to his advocacy.
3. Dedicating the community shelter in his name would be a well-deserved honor posthumously.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that:

4. The Tillamook County Board of Commissioners hereby proclaim that the community shelter located at Barview Jetty County Campground be named the "*Bradley K. Webster Community Shelter*".


