Authority for Adopting General Orders is found in Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 1, particularly ORS 1.230, 1.240, 1.250, 1.260, 1.270, as well as the statutes referring to Justice Courts generally in ORS chapters 51, 52, 53, 54, and 55. The Oregon Constitution of 1859 Article VII (Amended) and Article VII also provide a legal basis for this court's authority.

I HEREBY ORDER the following:

- The Tillamook County Justice Court shall not provide any in-person services. The Court shall not answer the phones during the established business hours. Nonessential staff shall not be in the Justice Court Office
- 2. The Court shall close. All filings, communication, and contact with the court shall be by mail. These filings and communications shall be entered when the Court reopens.
- 3. These restrictions go into effect by March 26, 2020 at 8:00 am. This order shall remain in effect until rescinded.
- 4. It is the intent of this order to comply fully with Tillamook County Board of Commissioners order 20-013.
- 5. This order takes effect immediately.
