RESOLUTION
#R-20-020

This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on June 10, 2020. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised of the records and files herein, finds as follows:

1. Under the emergency powers granted by ORS 401.305, on March 14, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-005 designating a State of Emergency within Tillamook County due to the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).
2. On March 22, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-006 closing within Tillamook County all transient lodging facilities.
3. On May 13, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-013 opening certain transient lodging facilities within Tillamook County and requiring transient lodging providers to adhere to certain guidelines attached and incorporated into said resolution.
4. On May 27, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-016 continuing the emergency through July 6, 2020.
5. The Board deems it is reasonable and appropriate to adjust the guidelines transient lodging providers are required to adhere to.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, the following are effective immediately:

6. All transient lodging providers shall adhere to the Oregon Health Authority cleaning guidelines.
